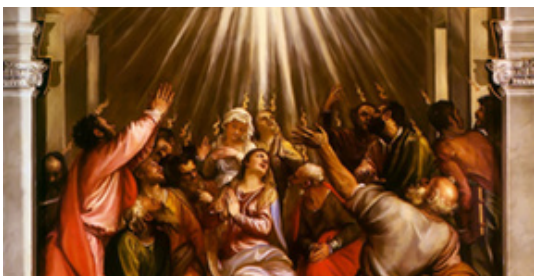
Prophets of Hope
